The draft Environmental Impact Statement and draft Management Plan proposed by NOAA outline a thoughtful plan to protect historical, resources of national significance.

- ● The recommended 52-square-mile designation in the Potomac River would include one of the largest collections of historical WWI era vessels, as well as Civil War, and Revolutionary War-era shipwrecks, Native American and other maritime artifacts.
- ● The local community will also benefit from recreation and tourism, particularly through enhancements to interpretative water trails and related visitor services. Charles County, Maryland, has already seen an increase in the number of visitors to Mallow's
