The Conservation Innovation Center (CIC) at the Chesapeake Conservancy develops tools and user-friendly web-based platforms to identify and prioritize conservation and restoration opportunities. Leveraging our high-resolution land cover and flow path datasets and partner-specific attribution, the tools identify and prioritize high-impact, cost-effective projects that maximize ecological benefits, such as water quality. These technologies reduce the cost and effort for implementing best management practices (BMPs), facilitating more projects.

Precision conservation for your property

If you are a landowner in Clinton, Centre, Huntingdon, Lancaster, or Lycoming Counties, Pennsylvania, this free, confidential tool can help you get information about the restoration opportunities on your property that can improve the ecological conditions you care about.

Using state-of-the-art data analysis, Restoration Reports generates a customized report for your property, including the watershed you are a part of, the wildlife species that may live on your property, and whether you are in close proximity to an impaired stream.

You can then select your management priorities, for example, improving the hunting and fishing on your property, or supporting your agricultural land uses.
